Efficient wear protection materials and an optimized design guarantee longer running times and shorter downtimes, while replacing the screen deck media, which play an important part in the process chain of all raw material extraction operations. Breaking down granular bulk goods into various grain sizes is one of the most important operations in process engineering and frequently takes place at several stages of the overall process. Screen deck media is not just used to separate materials by grain size, they are also used for dewatering, depulping and deslurrying.
